ANNUAL REPORT 2019

CAT MATCHERS

Dallas Cat Rescue, dba Cat Matchers is an allvolunteer 501c3 organization dedicated to reducing the number of homeless animals.

2019 YEAR IN REVIEW

HERE THEY ARE

Cat Matchers started 2019 with 223 cats in our foster cat system. Over the course of the year we took in 449 cats and kittens giving us 672 cats and kittens in our care. At the end of the year, we had 215 cats in foster care. \$8,327 spent on foster care. \$98,684 spent on veterinary care.

THERE THEY GO

Our adoption team carefully worked with potential adopters to match the right cat to the right home. These volunteers were able to place 359 cats and kittens into loving homes. We were able to place 65 additional cats through our transfer program and cats we were able to return to owner. \$851 spent on adoption expenses.

VOLUNTEERS

We had 82 volunteers, who put in 26,729 hours working adoptions, cleaning, foster care, transportation, social media, TNR, communications and special events: \$549 spent.

GRANTS

Dallas Companion Animal Project awarded Cat Matchers a \$5,000 for cats and kittens taken in from the Dallas Animal Shelter. We were able to provide veterinary and foster care for 33 cats with these funds.

SPECIAL EVENTS

We participated in 4 events last year raising over \$10,000 for our operations and spot-lighting our adoptable cats.

INCUBATORS

Through a few generous donors, we were able to purchase 3 incubators to care for neonatal kittens (birth to 4 weeks). Prior to the incubators, we had a 75%-80% survival rate; in 2019 we increased that to 90%. We have also increased our neonatal kitten intake by 40% in the last year.

OUR GENEROUS DONORS

This past year, we received over \$63,000 in donations from supporters which allowed us to work toward our goal to turn disposable animals into lifelong companions.

Cat Matchers' volunteers have adapted well to the situation. We quickly developed a virtual meet and greet environment and online adoption process. We were then able to transfer the cat to their owners with minimal contact.

This turned out to be a very positive way to do adoptions.

- This gave adopters a chance to see their potential new pet in a home environment.
- It also strengthened communication between our volunteers and adopters in case there were questions or concerns.
- This has helped us build better relationships with our adopters.

As things start opening up again and we resume our in-person adoptions, we will keep this virtual/online version of meeting for some of our foster cats who don't do well with the store events and for those potential adopters who prefer this method.
